

Preliminary allocation and final encumbrance of County Motor Vehicle License Tax (\$5) Funds to the City of Reynoldsburg (Engineer) (\$1,650,000.00)

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg has made a multi-year application for County Motor Vehicle License Tax funds available under Ohio Revised Code 4504.05 to improve Rose Hill Road between Livingston Avenue and Rosedale Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg has requested \$250,000 for this year's payment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg will request \$1,400,000 in 2009; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has approved this use of funds and has determined that the proposed work is necessary or conducive to the orderly and efficient flow of traffic within and through Franklin County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Reynoldsburg has also submitted final, detailed plans for said work to the County Engineer; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has approved said plans;

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That \$250,000.00 in County Motor Vehicle License Tax funds is hereby allocated and encumbered for the City of Reynoldsburg for their first payment to improve Rose Hill Road between Livingston Avenue and Rosedale Avenue.

Section 2) That, upon request by the City of Reynoldsburg through the County Engineer, the County Auditor shall draw a warrant for such encumbered amount on the County Treasurer payable to the City of Reynoldsburg.
