

**Resolution authorizing intergovernmental agreement for FY 2007  
Homeland Security Funds. (Emergency Management)  
(\$522,581.00)**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners has authorized the receipt of FY2007 State Homeland Security Grants issued to Franklin County for the purpose of enhancing Franklin County's First Responder capabilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners, and the Homeland Security Advisory Committee have approved the requested projects submitted by the city of Columbus for bomb squad mitigation equipment, radiation and chemical detection equipment, personal protection equipment, tow vehicle, and the design of an IED exercise; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ohio Emergency Management Agency has approved the projects as part of the Franklin County grants spending plan; and

**WHEREAS**, THE Franklin County Prosecuting Attorney has reviewed the intergovernmental agreement documents and found them to be acceptable as to form;
