

Resolution authorizing supplemental appropriations for the Public Assistance Fund (\$7,874,678) and the Champions for Children Fund (\$250,000) (Job & Family Services) (\$8,124,678)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services (JFS) has been informed by the State that effective July 1, 2008 the Federal Poverty Level limit for subsidized childcare eligibility is expanded from 185% to 200% of poverty, and thus the number of children eligible to receive subsidized childcare payments is increased; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Department of Job & Family Services has indicated that funding for the subsidized childcare program is a direct pass thru of federal dollars; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Department of Job & Family Services has indicated that eligibility was also expanded in the Champions for Children Fund, which are dollars reimbursed to the agency by private donors funding childcare for clients who do not qualify for the state’s subsidized childcare program; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Department of Job & Family Services has requested supplemental appropriations for the Public Assistance Fund (Fund 2012) in the amount of \$7,874,678 and the Champions for Children Fund (Fund 2080) in the amount of \$250,000, and a corresponding increase in revenue estimates; and now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

- 1. That appropriations in the amount of \$8,124,678 are hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #775):
