

**Resolution designating Tracy McConkey as an authorized agent for Franklin County and the Franklin County Engineer to perform all administrative duties regarding the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Public Assistance Program**

**(Franklin County Engineer)**

**WHEREAS**, on October 24, 2008 the President of The United States approved a proposal authorizing an Emergency Declaration for Public Assistance (DR-1805-OH), to numerous Ohio counties, which included Franklin County, to provide financial assistance to eligible local governments for recovery from a high wind event on September 14, 2008; and

**WHEREAS**, the eligible local governments in accordance with Federal Emergency Management Agency procedures, are required to designate an Authorized Agent as a primary contact who is responsible for performing all administrative duties necessary to file a request for funds on behalf of Franklin County and the Franklin County Engineer; and

**WHEREAS**, Tracy McConkey, Fiscal Officer for the Franklin County Engineer has access to the information that must be submitted to receive this Public Assistance reimbursement and the ability to maintain the supporting documentation, tracking costs, making appeals and performing audits; and

**WHEREAS**, Franklin County and the Franklin County Engineer desire to participate in the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Public Assistance program;

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That Tracy McConkey, Fiscal Officer for the Franklin County Engineer, is hereby designated as an Authorized Agent acting on behalf of the Franklin County Commissioners and the Franklin County Engineer to complete, sign and submit all documents pertaining to the Public Assistance Grant Program.
