

Resolution authorizing the acquisition of certain easements from the City of Columbus (Commissioners \$120,000)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners (the "Board"), in joint cooperation with the City of Columbus, desires to acquire easement rights in certain properties for public use and for future development in and around the Franklin County courthouse; and

WHEREAS, the City of Columbus has agreed to transfer to the Board a tunnel easement connecting the Franklin County Courthouse Complex (369-373-375 South High Street) to the new Courthouse site, on the north and south sides of Mound Street (see attachments) for One Hundred Twenty Thousand (\$120,000) Dollars; and **NOW, THEREFORE**,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That the Franklin County Board of Commissioners hereby accepts from the City of Columbus a quitclaim deed of easement for a tunnel connecting the Franklin County Courthouse Complex (369-373-375 South High Street) to the new Courthouse site, on the north and south sides of Mound Street as more particularly described in the attached legal description.

Section 2) That the attached purchase order in the amount of One Hundred Twenty Thousand (\$120,000), payable to the City of Columbus, is hereby approved.
