

Resolution authorizing a contract with Security Solutions International, LLC for the purchase of terrorism prevention training under the Law Enforcement State Homeland Security Grant Program

(OHS&JP \$9,000)

WHEREAS, the Law Enforcement State Homeland Security grant initiative authorizes contract/consultants to be paid for critical infrastructure and terrorism prevention training; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security has designated Information Gathering, Recognition of Indicators and Warnings, and Intelligence Analysis and Production as a National Priority for preparedness and homeland security; and

WHEREAS, the Terrorism Early Warning Group has identified Department of Homeland Security approved Security Solutions International, LLC as a leading provider of homeland security training; and

WHEREAS, Security Solutions International, LLC will deliver training at the cost of \$8,500 and provide an additional fifty training material packets for \$500 for a total contract of \$9,000; and

WHEREAS, Security Solutions International, LLC has provided a signed affidavit in compliance with Ohio Revised Code 3517.13; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Homeland Security and Justice Programs recommends the contract with Security Solutions International, LLC.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

The attached consultant agreement with Security Solutions International, LLC through the Law Enforcement State Homeland Security Grant in an amount not to exceed the estimated contract amount of \$8,500 for training services and \$500 for training materials for a total contract cost of \$9,000 is hereby approved.
