

Resolution requesting the Ohio Department of Transportation to reduce the speed limit on three sections of Snouffer Road, County Road No. 62, Franklin County, Ohio (Engineer)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Engineer's Office received a request from the City of Columbus to lower the existing speed limit of 45 m.p.h. on the following three sections of Snouffer Road, County Road No. 62, Franklin County, Ohio, to 40 m.p.h. to match the sections inside the City of Columbus:

From a point 0.27 miles west of Smoky Row Road to a point 0.15 miles west of Smoky Row Road (a total length of 0.12 miles); and

From Smoky Row Road to a point 0.10 miles east of Smoky Row Road (a total length of 0.10 miles); and

From a point 0.21 miles east of Smoky Row Road to a point 0.47 miles east of Smoky Row Road (a total length of 0.26 miles); and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Engineer's Office has completed a speed study on these three sections of Snouffer Road requiring the Franklin County Commissioners to request the Ohio Department of Transportation to evaluate the present speed limits; and

WHEREAS, the existing speed limit on these sections of Snouffer Road in the unincorporated areas is posted at 45 m.p.h. and the study warrants 40 m.p.h.; and

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That the Ohio Department of Transportation is hereby requested to investigate and determine the safe speed limit on three sections of Snouffer Road, County Road No. 62, Franklin County, Ohio, as detailed herein.

Section 2) That when the office of the Franklin County Engineer is notified of the change in speed limit, the appropriate signs will be erected.
