

Resolution authorizing County Engineer Dean C. Ringle to submit an application and execute project agreements on behalf of Franklin County for Ohio Department of Development Logistics and Distribution Stimulus Program funding of the Alum Creek Drive Corridor improvement projects (Engineer)

WHEREAS, the Logistics and Distribution Stimulus Program administered by the Ohio Department of Development provides funding to enhance the flow of freight and improve the ability to sell the State of Ohio as a logistics center; and

WHEREAS, the Alum Creek Drive Corridor is a key link for freight movement between the Rickenbacker Park area and the I-270 outerbelt; and

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has general charge of the County's system of thoroughfare roadways and is in the best position to coordinate projects on this particular multi-jurisdictional stretch of roadway;

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:
