

Resolution authorizing Franklin County Coroner's Office, under the direction of Jan Gorniak, D.O., Coroner, to submit applications and execute project agreements on behalf of Franklin County for 100% federally funded National Institute of Health Grant Opportunities

(CORONER)

WHEREAS, the greatest risk factor for anticipated, attempted and successful suicide is having experienced the recent loss of a loved one to violent or sudden, unexpected death; and

WHEREAS, the proposed project will bring an important counseling service for the target population of surviving loved ones in cases of suicide, homicide and accidental fatalities which are processed medico-legally through the Franklin County Coroner's Office; and

WHEREAS, the grant will fund 100% the services as outlined in the grant proposal which are currently not available to the residents of Franklin County; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Coroner's Office has requested permission to apply on the behalf of Franklin County for the above mentioned items; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That Cynthia L. Coleman, Director of the Franklin County Coroner's Office, is hereby authorized to submit applications as an Authorized Organizational Representative (AOR) to the National Institute of Health on behalf of the Franklin County Commissioners.
2. That notification will be made to the Commissioners upon the receipt of any grant funding.
