

Resolution authorizing a settlement to Karyl L. Slappy for a disputed vehicle damage claim due to an auto accident involving a Franklin County Public Facilities Management employee (Public Facilities Management) (\$2750.00)

WHEREAS, On September 30, 2008, a Franklin County Public Facilities Management employee was involved in an auto accident; and

WHEREAS, while traveling to the Downtown Complex from the East Complex, he turned left in front of an oncoming vehicle driven by Karyl L. Slappy near the intersection of Alum Creek Drive and Alum Industrial Drive; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County will pay the negotiated property damage settlement in the amount of two thousand seven hundred and fifty and 00/100 dollars (\$2750.00) to Karyl L. Slappy for the damages to her vehicle in the accident that occurred on September 30, 2008; and Karyl L. Slappy has accepted contingent on approval by the Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the above described settlement fairly compensates Karyl L. Slappy for the damages to her vehicle; and

WHEREAS, there are bodily injury claims arising out of this accident for which settlement has not been reached and which are separate from the property damage settlement involved herein;

WHEREAS, by agreeing to this settlement, neither the Public Facilities Management employee, the Franklin County Commissioners, nor Franklin County Public Facilities Management admits to any negligence or liability arising out of the auto accident; and

WHEREAS, the above described settlement, recommended by George Rittel of Rittel, Hill, and Zimmerman Adjuster Service, and Franklin County Fleet Management, deems it to be in the best interest of the Franklin County Board of Commissioners and Franklin County Public Facilities Management to settle the vehicle claim for two thousand seven hundred fifty and 00/100 (\$2750.00); and

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

1. That the above-referenced settlement in the amount of two thousand seven hundred fifty and 00/100 (\$2750.00) is in the best interest of the Franklin County Commissioners, Franklin County Public Facilities Management and the Department of Fleet Management and the same is hereby approved.
2. That upon execution of a full release in favor of the Franklin County Commissioners, Department of Fleet Management and Franklin County Public Facilities Management that is satisfactory to the Prosecutor's Office; a warrant is issued payable to Karyl L. Slappy, and forwarded to Rittel, Hill, and Zimmerman at 4920 Reed Road, Unit E, Columbus, Ohio 43220 as full and final settlement.
3. The attached Purchase Order in the amount of two thousand seven hundred fifty and 00/100 (\$2750.00) is hereby approved.
