

**Resolution authorizing a transfer of appropriations for the purchase of a replacement truck.
(Public Facilities Management) (\$35,125)**

WHEREAS, Public Facilities Management has requested appropriations within capital outlays to replace a truck and purchase a salt spreader with brine attachment; and

WHEREAS, the current truck, which was purchased in 2001, has been damaged as a result of an electrical fire and a collision; and

WHEREAS, Fleet Management has reported that the cost to repair the truck exceeds its value; and

WHEREAS, the salt spreader with brine attachment would allow Public Facilities Management to use salt brine product from the County Engineer, rather than the more expensive calcium ice melt that is currently used; and

WHEREAS, Public Facilities Management has available appropriations within materials and services to transfer to capital outlays; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That a transfer of appropriations in the amount of \$35,125 is hereby authorized as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #51):
