

Resolution declaring personal property as unneeded, obsolete or unfit and not needed for public use and authorizing the transfer of said items to other political subdivisions. (Public Facilities Management)

WHEREAS, Public Facilities Management ("PFM") has identified personal property as unneeded, obsolete or unfit and not needed for public use and listed said items on the attached listing.

WHEREAS, the Board of Franklin County Commissioners ("Board"), pursuant to the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Section 307.12, is authorized to declare personal property as unneeded, obsolete or unfit and not needed for public use and to transfer said items to other political subdivisions of the State.

WHEREAS, the Board adopted Resolution No. 683-06, on August 29, 2006, emphasizing its commitment to promote sustainable principles in policy decisions and programs.

WHEREAS, in keeping with the intent of Resolution 683.06, the Board encourages the adoption of waste management policies that reduce the environmental impact of solid waste and lessen the burden on the Franklin County landfill.

WHEREAS, the Board has considered the recommendation of PFM.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

That the Board declares the personal property identified by PFM and detailed in the attached listing as unneeded, obsolete or unfit and not needed for public use.

That the Board authorizes the transfer of that personal property identified by PFM and detailed in the attached listing to the Village of Harrisburg Division of Police and the Village of Valleyview Police Department.
