

Resolution authorizing the Franklin County Board of Commissioners to amend the County's 2008 Consolidated Plan allowing it to accept and utilize Stimulus Community Development Block Grant Recovery (CDBG-R) Funding under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA)

(Economic Development & Planning Department)

WHEREAS, the Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) has identified Franklin County, Ohio as a HUD entitlement Urban County and as such is eligible to accept and utilize Stimulus CDBG-R Program Funding under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA); and

WHEREAS, the County's funding allocation under the 2009 Stimulus CDBG-R Program is \$488,455 which is intended to be invested in economic development, housing, infrastructure and other public facilities activities that will quickly spur further economic investment, increased energy efficiency, and job creation or retention; and

WHEREAS, in order to apply for and accept the CDBG-R funding the County must amend its 2008 Consolidated Plan and submit the substantial amendment to HUD by June 5, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the President of the Board of Commissioners shall be the authorized representative and signatory of the substantial amendment and all related documents attached hereto and made a part hereof, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners, Franklin County, Ohio

That the attached substantial amendment to the County's 2008 Consolidated Action Plan for Stimulus CDBG-R Program Funding under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 is hereby adopted.
