

Resolution authorizing a Service Agreement between the Franklin County Board of Commissioners on behalf of the Department of Economic Development & Planning and the Franklin County Department of Public Facility Management to administer a Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) Neighborhood Stabilization (One) Program activity (Economic Development & Planning) (\$230,000.00)

WHEREAS, Franklin County has been awarded \$5,439,644 under the HUD Neighborhood Stabilization Program to address the problems of abandoned and foreclosed homes; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Neighborhood Stabilization Program is to provide targeted emergency assistance to acquire and redevelop foreclosed properties that might otherwise become sources of abandonment and blight within their communities; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Department of Public Facility Management will oversee the demolition component of the County's Neighborhood Stabilization Program; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners, Franklin County, Ohio

That the attached Service Agreement between the Franklin County Board of Commissioners on behalf of the Department of Economic Development & Planning and the Franklin County Department of Public Facility Management to administer a HUD Neighborhood Stabilization Program activity is hereby approved.
