

**Resolution authorizing the creation of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 – Child Support Enforcement Agency (ARRA CSEA) Fund, and to authorize a non-general fund supplemental appropriation for the stimulus funding received by Child Support Enforcement Agency through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (Child Support Enforcement Agency)(\$564,429.12)**

**WHEREAS,** Franklin County Child Support Enforcement Agency (CSEA) has received funding through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA); and

**WHEREAS,** the stimulus funding provided through ARRA is reimbursing Franklin County CSEA for expenses that have been made through the Child Support Enforcement Fund (Fund 2029); and

**WHEREAS,** the stimulus funding has been deposited into a new fund (Fund 2213) in order to maintain separate tracking of these dollars; and

**WHEREAS,** Franklin County CSEA has requested supplemental appropriations in order to account for the reimbursed expenses within this new CSEA ARRA fund; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That the Board of Commissioners hereby authorizes the creation of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 – Child Support Enforcement Agency (ARRA Stimulus) Fund (Fund 2213) to be used by the Child Support Enforcement Agency in support of ARRA-eligible activities.
2. That a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$564,429.12 is hereby authorized as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #30):
