

Resolution authorizing supplemental appropriations for the second portion of the Refugee Grant award for Senior Services (OFFICE ON AGING) (\$23,625)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Office on Aging has indicated that the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services has awarded a state refugee grant, in the amount of \$94,500, for the period beginning August 11, 2009 and ending November 29, 2009, for improving the ability of older refugees to access needed social and medical services in Franklin County;

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Office on Aging is the fiscal administrator for this grant which is a collaborative effort between the Franklin County Office on Aging, Community Refugee and Immigration Services and Cambodian Mutual Assistance Association; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Office on Aging has indicated that the amount and availability of these funds were not known at the time of the 2009 budget submission; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Office on Aging has received via Res No. 131-09 the first portion of the grant in the amount of \$70,875;

WHEREAS, this request is the second and final portion of the grant in the amount of \$23,625, and a one-time supplemental appropriation is being requested in order to distribute this grant; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

- 1. That supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$23,625 is hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #18):
