

**Resolution approving plans and authorizing the advertisement for construction of the Timberlake water treatment facility**

**(Sanitary Engineers)**

**Whereas**, the Timberlake subdivision in Pleasant Township currently receives water service from a facility, owned and operated by Cordell Utilities; and

**Whereas**, Cordell Utilities is having difficulties maintaining water service to the Timberlake Subdivision; and

**Whereas**, Franklin County has agreed to take ownership and become the operator of record for the Timberlake subdivision; and

**Whereas**, the Village of Harrisburg also requires public water services; and

**Whereas**, the new water treatment facility will produce enough drinking water for both the Timberlake subdivision and the Village of Harrisburg and exceed the requirements of the Safe Drinking Water Act; and

**Whereas**, the cost for the construction of the new water treatment facility will be paid from both ARRA funds and loans; and

**Whereas**, the plans for this project have been approved by the Franklin County Sanitary Engineer agency; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That the Franklin County Sanitary Engineer is authorized to advertised for bids for the construction of a new Timberlake water treatment facility and the plans are hereby approved.

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
