

Resolution awarding a Funding Agreement between the Board of Commissioners and the Community Shelter Board to implement Franklin County's Federal Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP)

(Economic Development & Planning Department) (\$746,920)

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners, Franklin County, Ohio has been awarded a federal Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP) funding allocation from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the purpose of addressing local homelessness by providing funding to prevent individuals and families from becoming homeless and help those who are experiencing homelessness to be quickly re-housed and stabilized; and

WHEREAS, the County's funding allocation under HPRP is \$746,920 which can be utilized to provide: short-term or medium-term rental assistance and housing relocation and stabilization services, including such activities as mediation, credit counseling, security or utility deposits, utility payments, moving cost assistance, and case management; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio wishes to designate the Community Shelter Board as the subrecipient to allocate its HPRP funds to eligible non-profit organizations, and to administer these funds; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners, Franklin County, Ohio

That the attached funding agreement between the Board of Commissioners and the Community Shelter Board to administer the County's Homelessness Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program (HPRP) is hereby adopted.
