

**Resolution authorizing a decrease in appropriations (\$148,768.85), an increase of appropriations (\$36,581.91), and the reorganization of positions related to the Antenna Systems Fund.  
(Office of Homeland Security & Justice Programs)**

**WHEREAS**, the Antenna Systems Fund (Fund 2031) and the associated Radio Communications Program is currently maintained and operated by Public Facilities Management (PFM); and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that the Office of Homeland Security and Justice Programs (OHS & JP) should be responsible for maintaining and operating the Antenna Systems Fund and a new Regional Communications Program; and

**WHEREAS**, this change will necessitate a transfer of positions from PFM to OHS&JP, as well as a reorganization of positions within OHS & JP; and

**WHEREAS**, the transfer and reorganization of positions will require a decrease in appropriations within the Justice Programs Fund (Fund 2083) and an increase of appropriations within the Antenna Systems Fund (Fund 2031) in order to support the positions for the six remaining pay periods in 2009; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That a decrease in appropriations in the amount of \$148,768.85 is hereby authorized as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #2):
2. That an increase of appropriations in the amount of \$36,581.91 is hereby authorized as follows and allocated per the attached document(Journal #30):
3. That the 800 MHz Administrator and Assistant 800 MHz Coordinator positions are hereby transferred from PFM to OHS & JP.
4. That the Disproportionate Minority Contact Coordinator and E-911 Coordinator positions within OHS & JP are hereby abolished.
