

Resolution authorizing a second supplemental appropriation to the Community Shelter Board in order to provide services to combat homelessness in our community (Community Partnerships) (\$658,930)

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners approved Resolution 113-09 on February 10, 2009 authorizing a collaboration agreement, pursuant to section 307.698 of the Revised Code, with the Community Shelter Board (CSB) to provide meaningful solutions and alternatives to combat homelessness in our community; and

WHEREAS, the collaboration agreement provided for support of up to \$3,000,000 based on one-half of the collections from the permissive real property and manufactured homes transfer fee; and

WHEREAS, because collections from the transfer fee were significantly lower this year due to the economic downturn and decline in the housing market over the past year, the Board of Commissioners authorized a \$1,000,000 supplemental appropriation with Resolution 740-09; and

WHEREAS, CSB requests additional year-end support to alleviate the continued shortfall in the collections from the transfer fee. Such support will enable CSB to provide the needed services to combat homelessness in the same manner as Resolution 113-09; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

That the attached purchase order with the Community Shelter Board in the amount of \$658,930 that is individually described on the accompanying Purchase Order Proof List is hereby approved.
