

Resolution authorizing supplemental appropriation for various purchases and treatment for Franklin County residents for services rendered from August 2009 to December 2009 (ADAMH) (\$2,000,000).

WHEREAS, Franklin County Alcohol, Drug, and Mental Health Services (ADAMH) has indicated that supplemental appropriations (\$2,000,000) are needed to pay for Medicaid services that has more than doubled the historical average of 6% in 2008 to 14.4%; and

WHEREAS, these additional appropriations will be used to purchase Mental Health and Alcohol & Other Drug treatment services for Franklin County residents; and

WHEREAS, Levy Contingency Appropriations, and American Recovery Reinvestment Act (ARRA) enhanced Medicaid reimbursements have alleviated \$8.4 Million of the appropriations shortage totaling \$10.4 Million, an additional \$2.0 Million is needed to meet the balance of 2009 ADAMH Board service obligations , now and therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRNAKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$2,000,000 is hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #1032)
