

Resolution authorizing an intergovernmental agreement between Franklin County and the City of Columbus, Ohio for the purpose of administering FY 2009 State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) and Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) grant funds. (OHS&JP)

WHEREAS, the Government of the United States of America has created funding resources through the Urban Area Security Initiative and State Homeland Security Program to assist local agencies' ability to prepare for, respond to and recover from all hazards incidents; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County serves as the fiscal agent for the Urban Area Security Initiative and State Homeland Security Grant; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the City of Columbus wish to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Franklin County to provide for the proper legal and audit controls required to expend homeland security grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Prosecuting Attorney has reviewed the intergovernmental agreement and found it to be acceptable as to form.

FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:
