

**Resolution authorizing the Franklin County Board of Commissioners to enter into Interlocal Agreements with the Cities of Columbus, Reynoldsburg and Whitehall to administer the FY 2009 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG).  
(OHS&JP)**

**WHEREAS**, the Board has authorized the receipt of the FY09 Justice Assistance Grants (JAG) for the purpose of improving and enhancing local criminal justice prevention and education and law enforcement training and response; and

**WHEREAS**, the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance has awarded \$498,193 to the Cities of Columbus, Reynoldsburg and Whitehall under the FY 2009 Justice Assistance Grant; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bureau of Justice Assistance has declared a disparate allocation status exists that requires an Interlocal Agreement between the Cities of Columbus, Reynoldsburg and Whitehall and Franklin County prior to accepting the award; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cities of Columbus, Reynoldsburg and Whitehall and Franklin County have established Memorandums of Understanding that detail the funding allocation and administration of the award; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Prosecuting Attorney has reviewed the interlocal agreements and found them to be acceptable as to form.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS,  
FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the Franklin County Commissioners are authorized to enter into Interlocal Agreements with the Cities of Columbus, Reynoldsburg and Whitehall to accept and administer the FY 2009 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG).
