

Resolution approving the Memorandum of Understanding Between the Chief Elected Officials, the Central Ohio Workforce Investment Board, and the Columbus and Franklin County One-Stop System Partners. (Job and Family Services)

WHEREAS, the Workforce Investment Act of 1998, as amended, as well as state regulations, requires a Memorandum of Understanding by and between the Chief Elected Officials, the Workforce Investment Board, and the One-Stop partners; and

WHEREAS, in conformity with the requirements of the Workforce Investment Act of 1998, as amended, as well as requirements of the State of Ohio, a Memorandum of Understanding setting forth the roles and relationships of the various One-Stop Partners in the operation of the One-Stop System has been developed for the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Commissioners, as the Chief Elected Officials representing Franklin County in the local workforce investment area known as Area 11, which comprises Franklin County, Ohio and the City of Columbus, Ohio, must approve and sign the Memorandum of Understanding.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:
