

Resolution authorizing the fourth and last annual payment to the City of Columbus to renovate the historic Lincoln Theatre (Community Partnerships) (\$1,000,000.00)

WHEREAS, renovation of the historic Lincoln Theatre, which is located in the King-Lincoln District, an urban historic district bordering downtown Columbus, is an important redevelopment effort for our community; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of the importance of this local historic landmark and the opportunity its renovation represents in the preservation of our community's heritage, as an economic investment and redevelopment initiative for the betterment of this urban neighborhood, the Franklin County Commissioners approved Resolution #307-07 to enter into a contract to support this renovation project; and

WHEREAS, the partnership between the Lincoln Theatre Association Board of Trustees and the Columbus Association for the Performing Arts (CAPA), the party managing the renovation and program development, has made possible the restoration and reopening of this important local landmark; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. The attached purchase order in the amount of \$1,000,000, which is individually described in the accompanying Purchase Order Proof List and the last payment of the four-year \$4,000,000 agreement, is hereby approved.
