WHEREAS, in 1983 the federal government passed legislation to honor and recognize the efforts of Reverend King; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to partner with the City of Columbus, Ohio in sponsoring activities recognizing the United States holiday marking the birth date of the of the Reverend Martin Luther King, Jr., as permitted per the provisions of ORC 307.691; and
