

Resolution authorizing intergovernmental agreements with the City of Columbus for the purpose of expending FY 2009 Urban Area Security Initiative and Law Enforcement State Homeland Security grant funds and Madison County for the purpose of expending FY 2008 and 2009 Urban Area Security Initiative grant funds. (OHS&JP)

WHEREAS, the Government of the United States of America has created funding resources through the Urban Area Security Initiative and Law Enforcement State Homeland Security Grant Program to assist local agencies' ability to prepare for, respond to and recover from all hazards incidents; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County serves as the fiscal agent for the Urban Area Security Initiative and Law Enforcement State Homeland Security Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, representatives of the City of Columbus and Madison County wish to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with Franklin County to provide for the proper legal and audit controls required to expend Urban Area Security Initiative and Law Enforcement State Homeland Security grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Homeland Security and Justice Programs recommends the Intergovernmental Agreements with the City of Columbus and Madison County.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:
