

Resolution of the Franklin County Board of Commissioners to convene into Executive Session for the purpose of considering pending or imminent litigation and collective bargaining matters

(COMMISSIONERS)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, public officials are required to take official action and to conduct all deliberations upon official business only in open meetings unless the subject matter is specifically excepted by law; and

WHEREAS, Section 121.22 (G)(1-7) of the Ohio Revised Code lists the matters exempted from open meeting requirements and authorized for discussion in Executive Session; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners from time to time has matters to discuss that are exempted from open meeting requirements; now therefore:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the Franklin County Board of Commissioners convene into Executive Session on Tuesday, April 6, 2010 at 9:00 A.M. for the following reason:

Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 121.22(G) (3) for the purpose of conferring with the Franklin County Prosecuting Attorney's Office concerning pending or imminent litigation.

Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 121.22 (G)(4), preparing for, conducting, or reviewing negotiations or bargaining sessions with public employees concerning their compensation or other terms and conditions of their employment; and
