

Resolution authorizing a sixth amendment to the 2010 Grant Agreement with the State of Ohio, Department of Youth Services **Court of Common Pleas, Division of Domestic Relations and Juvenile Branch) (\$30,500.00)**

WHEREAS, due to changes within three programs in the Base and Variable Allocation the Court of Common Pleas/Division of Domestic Relations and Juvenile Branch must submit a budget amendment; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Youth Services has requested the Work Detail Program be reclassified as the Restitution/Community Service program; and

WHEREAS, the targeted budget for mental health/counseling program needs to be reallocated to the providers, and

WHEREAS, the Disproportionate Minority Contact Initiative (DMC) wishes to hold six training sessions to address issues related to juveniles charged with domestic violence; and

WHEREAS, the training will be based upon educating families about building networks of support, conflict resolution, and the forty developmental assets curriculum; and

WHEREAS, the Court of Common Pleas, Division of Domestic Relation and Juvenile Branch recommends the amendments to the 2010 grant agreement; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the Amendment Form/Program Budget Summary with the State of Ohio, Department of Youth Services for the period of July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010 is hereby approved.
