

Resolution authorizing non-general fund supplemental appropriations for American Recovery and Reinvestment Act Violence Against Women Act subgrant award (Prosecuting Attorney)(\$3,244)

WHEREAS, the Office of Homeland Security and Justice Programs (OHS&JP) received an American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) award and a subgrant was awarded to the Prosecuting Attorney;

WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney was authorized supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$4,626 via Resolution 0287-10; and

WHEREAS, OHS&JP has informed the Prosecuting Attorney that additional funds are available through ARRA-VAWA; and

WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney has requested a supplemental appropriation of \$3,244 due to the increase in subgrant award, which is to be used to purchase a projector, laser printer and stand, brochure rack and two drawer filing cabinet; and

WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney will receive \$2,411 in grant funds and has sufficient cash in its Law Enforcement Trust Fund for the required cash match of \$833; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$3,244 are hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #4):
