

**The 2010 Resurfacing Program for Franklin County roads, Franklin County, Ohio, declared necessary and hearing fixed for Tuesday, July 6, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. (Engineer)**

**WHEREAS**, Section 5555.02 of the Ohio Revised Code provides that the Board of County Commissioners may construct a public road or improve an existing public road; and

**WHEREAS**, the Engineer of Franklin County, Ohio is hereby directed to make a survey, accurate and detailed construction plans, estimates of quantities, specifications and cost estimates, pursuant to Section 5555.07 of the Ohio Revised Code, and report to the Board of County Commissioners on or before July 6, 2010 at 9:00 a.m.; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost and expense of said improvement shall be paid out of proceeds of any levy or levies for road purchases on the grant duplicate of the County or out of any road improvement funds available therefore as provided in Section 5555.43 of the Ohio Revised Code;

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1) That the Board does hereby declare it necessary that proceedings be initiated for the improvement of various sections of the following roads with asphalt resurfacing and aggregate berm material:

Innis Road, Kropp Road, London & Lancaster Road, Lukens Road, Rings Road, Shier-Rings Road and Walnut Street.

Section 2) That legal notice be published on June 22, 2010 and June 29, 2010, pursuant to Section 5555.07 of the Ohio Revised Code, that it is necessary to make said improvement and that all information for said improvement is on file in the Office of the Board of County Commissioners for the inspection by all persons interested therein.

Section 3) That Tuesday, July 6, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. has been fixed as the time and the Office of the Board of County Commissioners the place for stating objections to said improvement.
