

**Resolution authorizing a transfer of funds from the General Fund to the Wireless 9-1-1 Fund for the payment of interest earnings from the first half of 2010.
(Commissioners)**

WHEREAS, Franklin County is responsible for the administration of Wireless 9-1-1 Government Assistance funds received from the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the funds from the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio are deposited into the Wireless 9-1-1 Fund (Fund 2130); and

WHEREAS, the interest earnings on the cash balance of the Wireless 9-1-1 Fund are deposited into the General Fund pursuant to section 135.351 of the Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Commissioners to transfer semi-annually the equivalent net interest earnings to the Wireless 9-1-1 Fund for distribution to the four municipalities operating the primary public service answering points; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

- 1. That a transfer of funds in the amount of \$8,840.66 is hereby authorized as follows and allocated per the attached document:
