

Resolution authorizing intergovernmental agreement with the City of Columbus for FY2009 Homeland Security Funds (Franklin County Emergency Management and Homeland Security) (\$139,508.00)

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has authorized the receipt of FY2009 State Homeland Security Grants issued to Franklin County for the purpose of enhancing Franklin County’s First Responder capabilities; and,

WHEREAS, all equipment purchased with Homeland Security grant funds is considered a regional asset and is available regionally; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, and the Homeland Security Advisory Committee have approved the requested projects submitted by the City of Columbus for Tactical Medic Team equipment, a regional Radiation Assessment Detector (RAD) and training projects (items listed on summary attached); and,

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Emergency Management and Homeland Security Executive Committee has reviewed and approved these funds; and,

WHEREAS, the Ohio Emergency Management Agency has approved the projects as part of the Franklin County grants spending plan; and,

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Prosecuting Attorney has reviewed the intergovernmental agreement documents and found them to be acceptable as to form; and,

WHEREAS, Franklin County Emergency Management and Homeland Security is responsible for maintaining all original records, forms, invoices and/or other related documents for audit purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

That the attached intergovernmental agreement with the City of Columbus is hereby approved with compensation not to exceed \$139,508.00.
