

Authorizing supplemental loan applications to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and Ohio Water Development Authority's Water Supply Revolving Loan Account and Water Pollution Control Loan Fund for construction of Timberlake facilities

(Sanitary Engineering)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sanitary Engineer has received funding via the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) for water and wastewater projects; and

WHEREAS, the grants from the ARRA funds provided only partial payment for the total cost to construct these projects; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) and Ohio Water Development Authority (OWDA) provides grants and loans to local governments for the purposes of making necessary infrastructure wastewater improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners authorized the County Administrator to sign all documents for and enter into an agreement with the OEPA and OWDA's Water Supply Revolving Loan Account (WSLRA) and Water Pollution Control Loan Fund (WPCLF) loans via Resolution 808-09; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sanitary Engineer intends to apply for supplemental loans to both the OEPA's WPCLF and the OWDA's WSRLA for construction of Timberlake wastewater and drinking water projects; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Water Supply Revolving Loan Account and Water Pollution Control Loan Fund requires the government authority to pass legislation for application of a supplemental loan and the execution of an agreement as well as designating a dedicated repayment source; now therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That the Franklin County Board of Commissioners authorizes the County Administrator to sign all documents for and enter into an agreement with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency and Ohio Water Development Authority's WSLRA and WPCLF supplemental loans.
