

**Resolution authorizing a transfer of appropriations to purchase a new server for Franklin County’s financial system (Franklin County Auditor)**

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Auditor has the responsibility of maintaining the Franklin County financial records, and its computer system, MUNIS, is an integral component of the financial process; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Auditor has been informed that MUNIS will soon no longer be supported by the Linux operating system/Informix database; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Auditor will need a second more robust server in order to migrate MUNIS to SQL; and

**WHEREAS**, the server purchased in 2009 will be configured into the MUNIS system to store data or will be released to the Data Center for their use; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Auditor has sufficient appropriation within their General Fund Materials and Services 2010 Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Auditor has requested to transfer the above mentioned appropriations to purchase the required server (\$11,000); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

- 1. That a one-time transfer of appropriations in the amount of \$11,000 is hereby authorized as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #2230):
