

Resolution authorizing immediate replacement of a section of sewer along Grener Road in Prairie Township (\$48,788.25)

(Sanitary Engineering)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners owns the sanitary sewer collection system in Prairie Township; and

WHEREAS, Prairie Township is performing road rehabilitation work on Grener Road; and

WHEREAS, during the Prairie Township's road rehabilitation work, a section of Franklin County's sanitary sewer collection system was uncovered; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sanitary Engineer's Office has inspected the section of sanitary sewer along Grener Road, and a licensed professional engineer has determined that the sewer line is in imminent danger of failure and requires immediate replacement to safeguard the public's health, safety, welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sanitary Engineers Office has, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 307.86, determined that replacement of the failing portion of the sewer line will cost less than fifty thousand dollars; and

WHEREAS, The Franklin County Sanitary Engineer's Office desires to hire Decker Construction Company to replace the section of sanitary sewer; and

WHEREAS, the cost for the replacement of the sanitary sewer will be paid from the Franklin County Sanitary Engineers Sewer Infrastructure Fund; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 307.86(A)(1), a real and present emergency exists with the Grener Road sewer collection line which will cost less than fifty thousand dollars to correct.

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2. That the Franklin County Sanitary Engineer is authorized to enter into a contract with Decker Construction Company to replace the damaged section of sewer along Grener Road in Prairie Township.
