

Resolution authorizing the Franklin County Board of Commissioners to enter into Interlocal Agreements with the cities of Columbus, Reynoldsburg, Gahanna and Whitehall to administer the FY 2010 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG). (OHS&JP)

WHEREAS, the Board has authorized the receipt of the FY10 Justice Assistance Grants (JAG) for the purpose of improving and enhancing local criminal justice prevention and education and law enforcement training and response; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance has awarded funding to the cities of Columbus, Reynoldsburg, Gahanna and Whitehall under the FY 2010 Justice Assistance Grant; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Justice Assistance has declared a disparate allocation status exists that requires an Interlocal Agreement between Franklin County and the cities of Columbus, Reynoldsburg, Gahanna, and Whitehall prior to accepting the award; and

WHEREAS, the cities of Columbus, Reynoldsburg, Gahanna and Whitehall and Franklin County have established Memorandums of Understanding that detail the funding allocation and administration of the award and will individually be awarded contracts; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Prosecuting Attorney has reviewed the interlocal agreements and found them to be acceptable as to form.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the Franklin County Commissioners are authorized to enter into Interlocal Agreements with the cities of Columbus, Reynoldsburg, Gahanna and Whitehall to accept and administer the FY 2010 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG).
