

Resolution entering into a Funding Agreement with the Mid-Ohio Board for an Independent Living Environment. Inc. (MOBILE) to provide hearing enhancement services to disabled, low-income County residents
(Economic Development & Planning Department) (\$25,000)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title I of the Housing and Community Development Acts of 1974 and 1977, as further amended, the Subrecipient has applied for and received a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for certain community development activities under the Franklin County Community Development and HOME Programs; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 99-10 the Franklin County Board of Commissioners adopted the County's 2010 Annual Action Plan to the Department of Housing and Urban Development acknowledging this community development need, fulfilling all requisite citizen participation requirements related to that plan and approving this allocation within; and

WHEREAS, this agreement will provide hearing enhancement services to disabled, low-income County residents; and

WHEREAS, the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 570.503, requires that a funding agreement be executed by the grant recipient the Franklin County Board of Commissioners and the grantee the Mid-Ohio Board for an Independent Living Environment (MOBILE) prior to the disbursement of County funds. No expenditures are anticipated to occur under this contract for the balance of 2010; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners, Franklin County, Ohio

That the attached Funding Agreement in the amount of \$25,000 between the Franklin County Board of Commissioners and the Mid-Ohio Board for an Independent Living Environment, Inc. (MOBILE) to provide hearing enhancement services to disabled, low-income County residents is hereby approved. No expenditures are anticipated to occur under this contract for the balance of 2010.
