

**Resolution to change the name of the Franklin County Law Library Conference Room to the Robert W. Werth Conference Room (Commissioners)**

WHEREAS, as a pillar in the Columbus legal community since 1965, Mr. Robert W. Werth has over 40 years experience in several practice areas, including business and commercial law, business bankruptcies, banking, commercial real estate, creditors' rights, construction law, workouts, mortgage and foreclosures, charitable giving, representation of non-profits, reorganizations and restructuring; and,
