

**Resolution authorizing an application to the Franklin County Court of Common Pleas for employment of legal counsel regarding labor relations matters during calendar year 2011.
(Commissioners)**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners may employ legal counsel upon approval of the Court of Common Pleas, upon proper application of the Board and the Prosecuting Attorney, pursuant to section 305.14 of the Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has a special need for representation regarding labor relations matters, including, but not limited to negotiating collective bargaining agreements with labor unions; and

WHEREAS, both the Board of Commissioners and the Prosecuting Attorney desire the employment of legal counsel from the law firm of Schottenstein, Zox & Dunn, and principally from Robert D. Weisman, Esq.; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That the Prosecuting Attorney be authorized to apply to the Court of Common Pleas of Franklin County, Ohio, pursuant to section 305.14 of the Revised Code, for the approval by the Court of the employment by the Board of Commissioners of Franklin County, Ohio, of the law firm of Schottenstein, Zox & Dunn, and principally from Robert D. Weisman, Attorney at Law, to represent the interests of Franklin County and the Board of Commissioners thereof in various labor relations matters during calendar year 2011.
