Resolution entering into a Service Agreement between the Economic Development and Planning Department and the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission for Housing Rehabilitation Services (ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING) (\$745,219.45)

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title I of the Housing and Community Development Acts of 1974 and 1977, as further amended, the Grantee has applied for and received a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) grant for certain community development activities; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution 99-10 the Franklin County Board of Commissioners acknowledged this community development need, fulfilled all relevant citizen participation requirements related to the identification and funding of that need and approved this allocation through the County's 2010 Annual Action Plan to the Department of Housing & Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, this agreement will provide housing rehabilitation services to low-income County residents; and

WHEREAS, the housing rehabilitation services will consist of three (3) components: an urgent repair services program; a handicap accessibility modification program and an urgent sewer needs repair program; and

WHEREAS, the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 570.503, requires that a funding agreement be executed by the grantee, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners, and the grant recipient the Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission (MORPC) prior to the disbursement of CDBG funds; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners, Franklin County, Ohio

That the attached Service Agreement between the Franklin County Department of Economic Development and Planning and MORPC for Urgent Repair Housing Services and the accompanying Purchase Order are hereby approved.
