

Resolution authorizing a settlement to Enterprise Car Rental for a disputed vehicle damage claim due to an auto accident (Job and Family Services' Office) (\$3,494.12)

WHEREAS, on July 21, 2010, Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services' employee, Robin James, was involved in an auto accident; and

WHEREAS, Robin James, driving a vehicle owned by Franklin County Commissioners, was west bound on East Spring Street at North High Street, did not obey the red light signal, and struck the vehicle owned by Enterprise Car Rental; and

WHEREAS, both vehicles sustained damage in the accident, and injuries were reported at the time of the accident, however no injury claims have been filed; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County will pay the amount of the damage of three thousand four hundred ninety four 12/100 dollars (\$3,494.12) as allowed by Ohio Revised Code to Enterprise Car Rental for damages to their vehicle in the accident that occurred on July 21, 2010; and Enterprise Car Rental has accepted contingent on approval by the Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the above described settlement fairly compensates Enterprise Car Rental for the damages to their vehicle; and

WHEREAS, by agreeing to this settlement, neither employee, Robin James, the Franklin County Commissioners, nor the Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services admits to any negligence or liability arising out of the auto accident; and

WHEREAS, the above described settlement, recommended by Franklin County Fleet Management, and the Prosecuting Attorney's Office, deems it to be in the best interest of the Franklin County Board of Commissioners and the Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services to settle the vehicle claim for three thousand four hundred ninety four 12/100 dollars (\$3,494.12); and

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BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

1. That the above-referenced settlement in the amount of three thousand four hundred ninety four 12/100 dollars (\$3,494.12) is in the best interest of the Franklin County Commissioners, Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services' Office and the Department of Fleet Management and the same is hereby approved.
2. That upon execution of a full release in favor of the Franklin County Commissioners, Department of Fleet Management and the Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services' Office that is satisfactory to the Prosecutor's Office; a warrant be issued payable to EAN Services, LLC Damage Recovery Unit, and forwarded to 600 Corporate Park Drive, St. Louis, MO 63105 as full and final settlement of this matter.
3. The attached Purchase Order in the amount of three thousand four hundred ninety four 12/100 dollars (\$3,494.12) is hereby approved.
