

Resolution authorizing a contract agreement with Stantec to provide professional engineering services for the Taylor Estates and Holton Park Wastewater Treatment Plant replacement projects (\$314,000.00)

(Sanitary Engineering)

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners recognizes the continuing need protect public health and the environment and improve water quality; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners via the Sanitary Engineering Department owns, operates, and maintains the Taylor Estates and Holton Park wastewater treatment plants, so named for the communities in which these facilities treat wastewater; and

WHEREAS, the existing Taylor Estates and Holton Park wastewater treatment plants have been identified as needing replacement with new facilities to maintain sanitary sewer service and mitigate environmental impacts; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners has issued and secured bonds via Resolution 787-10 to fund both the Taylor Estates and Holton Park wastewater treatment replacement projects; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sanitary Engineer recommends the approval of the Contract with Stantec to provide professional engineering services for the design, bidding, and construction phases of these projects; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That the attached Contract with Stantec in an amount not to exceed \$314,000.00 is hereby approved.
