

**Resolution authorizing non-general fund supplemental appropriations for warning sirens for the City of Columbus (Emergency Management & Homeland Security)**

**WHEREAS**, Franklin County wishes to ensure that residents are warned of dangers due to inclement weather; and

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Office of Emergency Management & Homeland Security (OEM&HS) operates and maintains a county-wide network of emergency warning sirens; and

**WHEREAS**, City of Columbus has requested to purchase and have installed ten (10) emergency warning sirens instead of the five (5) that were requested and approved in the 2011 Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, Franklin County Emergency Management has requested supplemental appropriations of \$85,170 to support the additional cost of five (5) sirens;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$85,170 are hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #2):
