

Resolution authorizing the First Amendment to the Agreement with Tybera Development Group for an Electronic Filing (eFiling) System

(Franklin County Court of Common Pleas)

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Franklin County Courts of Common Pleas, its Courts, the Clerk of the Probate Court and its Court, the Court of Appeals and Data Center (collectively, the "eGovernance Board") created the eGovernance Board in 2006 for purposes of implementing an Electronic Filing (eFiling) System; and

WHEREAS, the eGovernance Board recommends to the Board of Commissioners that the County enter into a First Amendment to the Services Agreement and the E-Filing Software Implementation, License and Maintenance Agreement (collectively, the "First Amendment") with the Contractor upon the terms and conditions outlined in the attached First Amendment; and

WHEREAS, the First Amendment adjusts the timeline to reflect the changes of the timeline for the testing of the modules and to change the payment schedule based on the changes to the timeline without any change to the overall price of the project; and

WHEREAS, the eGovernance Board, under eGovernance Board Resolution #2011-1, recommended that the Board of Commissioners approve the First Amendment; and

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

That the attached First Amendment to the Services Agreement and the E-Filing Software Implementation, License and Maintenance Agreement with Tybera Development Group is hereby approved.
