

Resolution rejecting Fact Finder David W. Stanton's Report concerning collective bargaining negotiations between the Franklin County Sheriff's Office and the Fraternal Order of Police, Capital City Lodge 9 and encouraging both parties to continue discussions and reach a mutual agreement

(COMMISSIONERS)

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners encourage further discussions between the Sheriff's Office and the Fraternal Order of Police to reach a mutual agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners respect the collective bargaining process as an effective way for labor and management to discuss and resolve issues of interest; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Sheriff's Office and the Fraternal Order of Police, Capital City Lodge 9 which represents Unit A (all full time, sworn, uniform, non-supervisory deputies below the rank of corporal and known as the "Deputy Unit"); and Unit B (all full time sworn uniformed supervisory deputies of the rank of corporal, sergeant, lieutenant, and captain and known as "the Supervisor Unit") have been engaged in collective bargaining negotiations; and

WHEREAS, management and labor representatives sought the assistance of a Fact Finder from the State Employee Relations Board to review issues where agreement had not been achieved; and

WHEREAS, the Fact Finder, David W. Stanton, issued his report and recommendations on May 12, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Board of Commissioners do not accept the recommendations of the Fact Finder; now, therefore,
