

Resolution authorizing non-general fund supplemental appropriations for warning siren upgrade parts for the City of Dublin (Emergency Management & Homeland Security)

WHEREAS, Franklin County wishes to ensure that residents are warned of dangers due to inclement weather; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin County Office of Emergency Management & Homeland Security (OEM&HS) operates and maintains a county-wide network of emergency warning sirens; and

WHEREAS, the City of Dublin operates a separate warning siren system and has requested to purchase warning siren upgrade parts in the amount of \$135,650.96; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Emergency Management has agreed to purchase the upgrade parts for the City of Dublin which will be repaid to OEM&HS in order to receive the savings OEM&HS receives directly from the manufacturer;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

1. That supplemental appropriations in the amount of \$135,650.96 are hereby authorized from the unappropriated cash balance as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #2623):
