

**Resolution authorizing the transfer of title of retired police vehicles to other law enforcement agencies in Ohio. (Fleet Management)**

**WHEREAS**, Ohio Revised Code 307.12 authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to dispose of surplus county personal property; and

**WHEREAS**, Fleet Management and the Sheriff's Office have determined that the maintenance costs of a large fleet of high mileage patrol cruisers is prohibitive and out-of-service time too great; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the operational nature of the Franklin County Sheriff's Office Patrol division these vehicles are operated multiple shifts daily and accumulates miles quickly, while the smaller law enforcement agencies operate the vehicles one shift per day reducing the mileage significantly; and

**WHEREAS**, other law enforcement agencies in Ohio have asked for these retired vehicles to help upgrade their small fleet of aging vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Fleet Management currently has retired vehicles as listed on the attached document; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Fleet Management can eliminate much of the cost of removing decals and equipment from these vehicles otherwise required to sell the vehicles at public auction; and

**WHEREAS**, these other law enforcement agencies have expressed a need for used patrol cruisers for their use in enforcement activities within their jurisdiction; an

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO;

That the Director of Fleet Management is hereby authorized to transfer the titles of the listed retired vehicles to other law enforcement entities.
