

**Resolution authorizing a transfer of non-general fund appropriations in the Wireless 9-1-1 Fund to properly account for payments to other county offices.
(Commissioners)**

WHEREAS, Franklin County is responsible for the administration of Wireless 9-1-1 Government Assistance funds received from the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the funds from the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio are deposited into the Wireless 9-1-1 Fund (Fund 2130); and

WHEREAS, the resolution of the Franklin County 9-1-1 Planning Committee approved on December 1, 2009 authorized payments from the Wireless 9-1-1 Fund to the Franklin County Sheriff’s Office and the Office of Homeland Security & Justice Programs; and

WHEREAS, the 2011 budget includes appropriations within the interfund category to support these payments; and

WHEREAS, a transfer of appropriations is necessary to properly account for these payments as grants rather than as interfund transfers; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

That a transfer of appropriations in the amount of \$348,251.01 is hereby authorized as follows and allocated per the attached document (Journal #77):
