

**Resolution authorizing a Funding Agreement Amendment between the Economic Development and Planning Department and Homes on the Hill Community Development Corporation to rehabilitate eight (8) homes for low-income families**  
(Economic Development & Planning Department) (\$250,000)

**WHEREAS**, the Franklin County Department of Economic Development & Planning and Homes on the Hill CDC on behalf of Franklin County competitively applied for and were awarded \$250,000 in HOME Partnership funds from the Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) to rehabilitate eight (8) homes for low-income families; and

**WHEREAS**, under this Agreement Amendment the County will be adding \$250,000 in Community Housing Development Organization (CHDO) HOME funds to the project (bringing the total allocation to \$500,000; \$250,000 was originally awarded under resolution 308-10) to rehabilitate eight (8) homes for low-income families; and

**WHEREAS**, the rehabilitation of these homes will both address the Franklin County priority of providing safe, affordable housing to its residents as well as serve the Board of Commissioners stated commitment to sustainability as embodied in Resolution 683-06; and

**WHEREAS**, the Code of Federal Regulations, Section 570.503, requires that a funding agreement be executed by the grant recipient-- Franklin County Commissioners--and Homes on the Hill CDC prior to the disbursement of HOME funds; now

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners, Franklin County, Ohio

That the attached Funding Agreement and purchase order in the amount of \$250,000 between the Economic Development and Planning Department and Homes on the Hill CDC to rehabilitate eight (8) homes for low-income families is approved.
